

RYE IPA

Malt Varieties: Organic Pale, Organic Munich, Organic Chocolate, Vienna, Victory, Malted and Flaked Rye

Hop Varieties: Columbus, Simcoe, Cascade, Glacier

OG: 13.6°P

ABV: 4.9%

IBU: 71

Description: Our first attempt at this unusual style of beer builds a hop-driven IPA w/ significant bitterness atop a solid malt foundation using a small percentage of both flaked and malted rye.

Rye imparts a mildly spicy and crisp grainy flavor, contributing complexity without being overwhelming.

Appearance: Dark amber and slightly hazy.

Flavor: Medium to medium-full texture with slight spiciness from rye and lingering bitterness from early hop additions.

History: Rye has been a staple of North and Central European diets due to its ability to thrive in poor soil conditions.

It has also been used in bread as well as distilled spirits.
